



Job Description: Equestrian Assistant Instructor

Position Summary

The Equestrian Instructor is responsible for the delivery of TUF's equestrian programs and classes (ages 5-18). This position reports to the Equine Program Manager.

Essential Job Functions

TUF Equine Education

- Assists the head instructor of each class with the riders, from tacking and grooming to mounting and riding
- Teach assigned educational topics to help prepare riders for the written test
- Assist in maintaining equipment for the equine program. This includes but is not limited to, following procedures for the care of tack and upkeep of the arena in preparation for classes and clean-up post class.

Qualifications

- Must ride/have knowledge at an Intermediate 1 level or higher
- Ability to follow instructions well and work as a team with head instructor
- Experience teaching both mounted and unmounted lessons in horsemanship
- Embodies the high standard of safety when working with horses and riders
- A passion for The Urban Farm's mission
- Good written and verbal communications skills
- Ability to arrive to work on a timely and consistent manner

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience working with youth in an educational setting
- Previous experience teaching and or assisting with equine instruction

Work Environment

- Most time will be spent outdoors or in the arena in various weather conditions.
- Work is accomplished with moderate supervision. Work is reviewed for accuracy and overall adequacy.
